BEST PRACTICES FOR SUCCESS

THOROUGH REVIEW OF MATERIALS: CAREFULLY REVIEW ALL PROVIDED UHC TRAINING MATERIALS, INCLUDING THE CODE OF CONDUCT, COMPLIANCE GUIDELINES, AND ANY ACCOMPANYING PRESENTATIONS.

FOCUS ON UNDERSTANDING, NOT MEMORIZATION: INSTEAD OF SIMPLY MEMORIZING FACTS, STRIVE TO UNDERSTAND THE UNDERLYING ETHICAL PRINCIPLES AND LEGAL IMPLICATIONS OF DIFFERENT SCENARIOS. THIS WILL BETTER EQUIP YOU TO ANSWER A WIDER RANGE OF QUESTIONS.

PRACTICE WITH HYPOTHETICAL SCENARIOS: WORK THROUGH HYPOTHETICAL SCENARIOS RELATED TO ETHICAL DILEMMAS AND REGULATORY COMPLIANCE ISSUES. THIS WILL HELP YOU APPLY YOUR KNOWLEDGE IN A PRACTICAL CONTEXT.

SEEK CLARIFICATION: IF YOU ENCOUNTER ANY CONCEPTS YOU FIND UNCLEAR, SEEK CLARIFICATION FROM YOUR MANAGER, HR REPRESENTATIVE, OR COMPLIANCE OFFICER.

FAILURE TO REPORT VIOLATIONS: KNOWING HOW AND WHEN TO REPORT POTENTIAL ETHICAL VIOLATIONS IS ESSENTIAL.
