COMMON PITFALLS:

NEGATIVITY: AVOID SPEAKING NEGATIVELY ABOUT PREVIOUS EMPLOYERS OR COLLEAGUES.

LACK OF PREPARATION: FAILING TO RESEARCH THE ORGANIZATION OR PRACTICE ANSWERING COMMON QUESTIONS.
