#### FAQs:

1. Is it okay to express my disappointment if I get no response after my second follow up email? Avoid expressing disappointment directly in the email. It's best to wait and explore other opportunities.

1. What if the hiring manager responded to my first follow-up, but not my second? This is unusual. Perhaps check your spam folder. If the message was in your inbox, a polite phone call may be

justified, but keep it brief and respectful.
