ASKING THIS QUESTION FORCES US TO CONFRONT THE UNCOMFORTABLE TRUTH THAT EVEN AFTER SIGNIFICANT LEGAL VICTORIES, DEEP-SEATED BIASES AND INEQUITIES CONTINUE TO MANIFEST IN AREAS SUCH AS CRIMINAL JUSTICE, EDUCATION, HEALTHCARE, AND ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY. IT PROMPTS A CRITICAL EXAMINATION OF THE STRATEGIES AND APPROACHES NEEDED TO DISMANTLE SYSTEMIC RACISM EFFECTIVELY, A TASK FAR MORE COMPLEX THAN THE LEGISLATIVE ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ERA. THIS NECESSITATES A THOROUGH RE-EVALUATION OF POLICY, SOCIETAL NORMS, AND INDIVIDUAL ACTIONS TO ADDRESS THE INSIDIOUS WAYS RACISM PERPETUATES ITSELF.

H2: QUESTION 2: IN AN ERA OF INCREASING POLARIZATION, HOW CAN WE EFFECTIVELY EMPLOY NONVIOLENT RESISTANCE IN THE FACE OF OPPRESSION?
