STEP 2: TWO-STEP DIRECTIONS: ONCE THE CLIENT DEMONSTRATES MASTERY OF SINGLE-STEP DIRECTIONS, THE THERAPIST INTRODUCES TWO-STEP INSTRUCTIONS. THESE ARE CAREFULLY CONSTRUCTED TO BUILD UPON THE PREVIOUSLY LEARNED SKILLS. FOR INSTANCE, “PICK UP THE BLUE BLOCK AND PLACE IT ON THE RED TABLE.” THE THERAPIST PROVIDES VISUAL CUES AND BREAKS DOWN THE STEPS IF NEEDED.

STEP 3: THREE-STEP DIRECTIONS: FINALLY, THE CLIENT PROGRESSES TO THREE-STEP INSTRUCTIONS, SUCH AS, “PICK UP THE

BLUE BLOCK, PLACE IT ON THE RED TABLE, AND THEN PUT THE GREEN BLOCK NEXT TO IT.” THE COMPLEXITY OF THE INSTRUCTIONS IS GRADUALLY INCREASED TO CHALLENGE THE CLIENT WHILE MAINTAINING A MANAGEABLE LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY.
