SOLUTION: SINCE $\angle 3$ AND $\angle 6$ ARE CONSECUTIVE INTERIOR ANGLES AND THEY ARE SUPPLEMENTARY (GIVEN), WE CAN CONCLUDE THAT LINES L AND M ARE PARALLEL BASED ON THE CONSECUTIVE INTERIOR ANGLES THEOREM.
