METHODOLOGIES FOR ANSWERING TECHNICAL QUESTIONS: PREPARE THOROUGHLY BY REVIEWING RELEVANT TECHNICAL CONCEPTS AND PRACTICING COMMON QUESTIONS RELATED TO YOUR FIELD. BE HONEST ABOUT YOUR LIMITATIONS, BUT HIGHLIGHT YOUR EAGERNESS TO LEARN AND ADAPT.

1. SITUATIONAL INTERVIEW QUESTIONS: THESE QUESTIONS PRESENT HYPOTHETICAL SCENARIOS AND ASSESS YOUR PROBLEM-SOLVING SKILLS AND DECISION-MAKING ABILITIES. FOR EXAMPLE:
