Beside their role in energy metabolism, oligosaccharides, which represent the third class of biomacromolecules, have received less attention. Today it is well established that oligosaccharides are involved in many important biological regulation and recognition processes from protein folding to cell-cell communication. Glycosylation of proteins is the most complex form of co- and posttranslational modification. The determination of structure-function relationships, however, remains difficult due to the microheterogeneity of glycoproteins that exist in many different glycoforms.
