FOR EXAMPLE, DESCRIBE A CONTEXT IN WHICH A TOTAL NUMBER OF OBJECTS CAN BE EXPRESSED AS 5×7 ." THIS STANDARD GOES BEYOND SIMPLE MEMORIZATION OF MULTIPLICATION FACTS. IT REQUIRES STUDENTS TO UNDERSTAND THE CONCEPT OF MULTIPLICATION AS REPEATED ADDITION AND TO VISUALIZE THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN FACTORS AND PRODUCTS. SIMILARLY, IT REQUIRES COMPREHENSION OF DIVISION AS BOTH SHARING AND GROUPING.

THE ROLE OF 3.OA.1 WORKSHEETS IN ACHIEVING MASTERY

DIVISION WORKSHEETS: THESE WORKSHEETS FOCUS ON DEVELOPING AN UNDERSTANDING OF DIVISION AS BOTH SHARING AND GROUPING, WITH EMPHASIS ON DIVISION PROBLEMS WITHIN 100.
