ADDRESSING THIS EQUITY GAP REQUIRES TARGETED INTERVENTIONS AND SUPPORT.

**WRITING TOOLS:** TECHNOLOGY CAN SUPPORT WRITING DEVELOPMENT THROUGH TOOLS LIKE GRAMMAR CHECKERS, SPELL CHECKERS, AND ONLINE WRITING PLATFORMS THAT PROVIDE FEEDBACK.

ASSESSMENT IN 3RD GRADE LANGUAGE ARTS SHOULD BE MULTIFACETED, ENCOMPASSING BOTH FORMATIVE AND SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENTS. THE FOCUS SHOULD BE ON USING ASSESSMENT DATA TO INFORM INSTRUCTION AND SUPPORT STUDENT GROWTH RATHER THAN SOLELY FOCUSING ON STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES.
