LEVELS OF THE PARTICIPANTS. QUESTIONS THAT ARE TOO EASY CAN BE DEMOTIVATING, WHILE THOSE THAT ARE TOO DIFFICULT CAN BE DISCOURAGING AND CREATE AN UNFAIR PLAYING FIELD. A WELL-STRUCTURED QUIZ INCORPORATES A RANGE OF DIFFICULTY LEVELS TO CATER TO DIVERSE SKILL SETS.

1. AVOIDING AMBIGUITY AND BIAS: QUESTIONS MUST BE CLEARLY WORDED, AVOIDING JARGON OR TERMINOLOGY THAT MIGHT CONFUSE PARTICIPANTS. AMBIGUOUS PHRASING CAN LEAD TO INCORRECT ANSWERS AND DISPUTES. FURTHERMORE, QUESTIONS SHOULD BE FREE FROM BIAS, ENSURING THAT ALL PARTICIPANTS HAVE AN EQUAL OPPORTUNITY TO DEMONSTRATE THEIR KNOWLEDGE.
1. SEEK FEEDBACK AND REVIEW: BEFORE THE COMPETITION, TEST THE QUESTIONS WITH A SMALL GROUP TO IDENTIFY AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT.

FOCUS ON APPLICATION OF KNOWLEDGE: DEVELOP QUESTIONS THAT REQUIRE PARTICIPANTS TO APPLY THEIR KNOWLEDGE TO SOLVE PROBLEMS OR ANSWER HYPOTHETICAL SCENARIOS.

MAINTAIN A BALANCE BETWEEN FACTUAL RECALL AND APPLIED KNOWLEDGE: THE QUIZ SHOULDN'T RELY SOLELY ON ROTE MEMORIZATION.
