4 STEPS TO SOLVING A PROBLEM: A CRITICAL ANALYSIS OF A TIMELESS APPROACH IN A COMPLEX WORLD

STEP 2: GENERATING SOLUTIONS: BRAINSTORMING, LATERAL THINKING, AND OTHER CREATIVE PROBLEM-SOLVING TECHNIQUES ARE ESSENTIAL AT THIS STAGE. THE AIM IS NOT TO JUDGE SOLUTIONS PREMATURELY BUT TO GENERATE A WIDE RANGE OF

HOWEVER, THIS STEP OFTEN FALLS SHORT WHEN INDIVIDUALS OR TEAMS LACK THE NECESSARY EXPERTISE OR DIVERSE PERSPECTIVES, HINDERING THE GENERATION OF EFFECTIVE AND INNOVATIVE SOLUTIONS. IN TODAY'S INTERCONNECTED WORLD, LEVERAGING COLLECTIVE INTELLIGENCE THROUGH COLLABORATIVE PLATFORMS AND DIVERSE TEAMS IS CRITICAL FOR SUCCESSFUL APPLICATION OF THE "4 STEPS TO SOLVING A PROBLEM".

STEP 3: SELECTING THE BEST SOLUTION: THIS INVOLVES EVALUATING THE GENERATED SOLUTIONS BASED ON VARIOUS CRITERIA, SUCH AS FEASIBILITY, COST-EFFECTIVENESS, AND POTENTIAL IMPACT.
