REMAINDER: THE AMOUNT LEFT OVER AFTER DIVIDING EVENLY.

STRATEGIES FOR MASTERING 4TH GRADE MATH DIVISION:

SEVERAL EFFECTIVE STRATEGIES CAN BE USED TO TEACH AND LEARN 4TH GRADE MATH DIVISION:

FACT FAMILIES: UNDERSTANDING FACT FAMILIES (RELATED ADDITION, SUBTRACTION, MULTIPLICATION, AND DIVISION EQUATIONS) REINFORCES THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THESE OPERATIONS AND ENHANCES PROBLEM-SOLVING SKILLS. FOR EXAMPLE, THE FACT FAMILY FOR 4, 5, AND 20 INCLUDES: $4 \times 5 = 20$, $5 \times 4 = 20$, $20 \div 4 = 5$, AND $20 \div 5 = 4$.

1. LONG DIVISION: BY THE END OF 4TH GRADE, STUDENTS ARE INTRODUCED TO THE ALGORITHM OF LONG DIVISION. THIS METHODOICAL APPROACH BREAKS DOWN LARGER DIVISION PROBLEMS INTO SMALLER, MANAGEABLE STEPS, FOCUSING ON THE SEQUENCE OF DIVIDE, MULTIPLY, SUBTRACT, AND BRING DOWN.
