The absence of a palpable pulse distal to the suspected site of vascular injury strongly suggests impaired arterial blood flow. Careful palpation of peripheral pulses (radial, ulnar, dorsalis pedis, posterior tibial) is crucial, comparing them to the corresponding pulses in the uninjured limb. The absence of a pulse doesn't automatically confirm arterial occlusion; the pulse might be weak or difficult to palpate due to factors such as peripheral vasoconstriction or edema. Doppler ultrasound can assist in confirming the presence or absence of a pulse when manual palpation is inconclusive. Careful attention to the 5 P's in neurovascular assessment helps establish the extent of the issue.

1. Paresthesia:

Paresthesia refers to abnormal sensations such as numbness, tingling, or pins and needles. This arises from nerve ischemia due to reduced blood supply. It's a significant finding, indicating nerve dysfunction secondary to compromised blood flow. The distribution of paresthesia can help localize the area of vascular compromise. Similar to pain and pallor, the intensity and extent of paresthesia correlate with the severity of ischemia.

1. Paralysis:

Paralysis, or loss of motor function, is a late sign of severe ischemia. It signifies significant compromise of the blood supply to the nerves and muscles of the affected limb. The onset of paralysis constitutes a surgical emergency requiring immediate intervention to restore blood flow. The 5 P's in neurovascular assessment, particularly the appearance of paralysis, necessitates urgent action to prevent irreversible damage.
