THIS HANDS-ON APPROACH PROVED FAR MORE EFFECTIVE THAN ROTE MEMORIZATION.

THE IMPORTANCE OF VISUAL AIDS AND PRACTICE

The new edition features an extended introduction covering the key ideas in the book (which itself has been updated with additional examples and appendices) and significant new results which have appeared since the first edition.
