CHALLENGES CAN EMERGE IN DISTINGUISHING KITES FROM OTHER QUADRILATERALS, WHILE OPPORTUNITIES EXIST IN USING HANDS-ON ACTIVITIES WITH MANIPULATIVES TO CONSTRUCT AND ANALYZE KITES, FOSTERING SPATIAL REASONING.

1. KEY (IN PROBLEM-SOLVING): WHILE NOT A DIRECT MATHEMATICAL TERM, "KEY" OFTEN DESCRIBES CRUCIAL INFORMATION OR STEPS WITHIN A PROBLEM. IDENTIFYING THE KEY INFORMATION IS A VITAL PROBLEM-SOLVING SKILL EMPHASIZED THROUGHOUT 5TH GRADE MATHEMATICS. THE CHALLENGE LIES IN TEACHING STUDENTS TO CRITICALLY ANALYZE WORD PROBLEMS AND EXTRACT ONLY THE RELEVANT INFORMATION. OPPORTUNITIES ARISE IN TEACHING STRATEGIES FOR IDENTIFYING KEY WORDS AND PHRASES.
