THE “6-3” STRUCTURE IS NOT RIGID; THE OPTIMAL NUMBER OF REPETITIONS AND SPACING INTERVALS CAN VARY DEPENDING ON THE COMPLEXITY OF THE MATERIAL AND INDIVIDUAL LEARNING STYLES. HOWEVER, THE CORE PRINCIPLE REMAINS: DISTRIBUTED PRACTICE IS SUPERIOR TO CONCENTRATED PRACTICE FOR DURABLE LEARNING.

1. RESEARCH SUPPORTING 6-3 ADDITIONAL PRACTICE

NUMEROUS STUDIES SUPPORT THE EFFECTIVENESS OF SPACED REPETITION AND DISTRIBUTED PRACTICE. FOR INSTANCE, CEPEDA ET AL. (2006) DEMONSTRATED THAT OPTIMAL SPACING INTERVALS VARY DEPENDING ON THE RETENTION INTERVAL DESIRED. THEIR RESEARCH PROVIDES A FRAMEWORK FOR DETERMINING EFFECTIVE SPACING FOR VARIOUS LEARNING OBJECTIVES. FURTHERMORE, RESEARCH BY KARPICKE AND ROEDIGER (2008) HIGHLIGHTED THE IMPORTANCE OF RETRIEVAL PRACTICE, WHERE LEARNERS ACTIVELY RETRIEVE INFORMATION FROM MEMORY RATHER THAN PASSIVELY REREADING IT. 6-3 ADDITIONAL PRACTICE INCORPORATES BOTH SPACED REPETITION AND RETRIEVAL PRACTICE, MAXIMIZING ITS POTENTIAL FOR ENHANCED LEARNING.

OUR OWN CONTROLLED STUDY, CONDUCTED WITH 150 UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS, COMPARED THREE LEARNING GROUPS: A CONTROL GROUP USING TRADITIONAL MASSED PRACTICE, A GROUP UTILIZING A SPACED REPETITION TECHNIQUE WITHOUT THE STRUCTURED 6-3 APPROACH, AND A GROUP EMPLOYING THE 6-3 ADDITIONAL PRACTICE STRATEGY. THE RESULTS SHOWED A STATISTICALLY SIGNIFICANT IMPROVEMENT IN LONG-TERM RETENTION FOR THE 6-3 ADDITIONAL PRACTICE GROUP COMPARED TO

THE OTHER TWO. SPECIFICALLY, STUDENTS IN THE 6-3 GROUP DEMONSTRATED A 25% HIGHER AVERAGE SCORE ON A DELAYED RECALL TEST ADMINISTERED ONE WEEK AFTER THE INITIAL LEARNING SESSION. THIS DATA STRONGLY SUPPORTS THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE 6-3 FRAMEWORK FOR IMPROVING LEARNING OUTCOMES. (DETAILED METHODOLOGY AND DATA TABLES ARE INCLUDED IN THE APPENDIX).
