AVOID SOFTBALL QUESTIONS; AIM FOR THOSE THAT ENCOURAGE DEEPER REFLECTION AND HONEST ANSWERS. CONSIDER INCORPORATING ELEMENTS OF HIS PAST STATEMENTS OR ACTIONS TO PROMPT SELF-REFLECTION. EXAMPLES INCLUDE:

E. BEING OVERLY CONFRONTATIONAL: WHILE CHALLENGING BARKLEY IS EXPECTED, EXCESSIVE CONFRONTATION CAN DAMAGE THE INTERVIEW'S INTEGRITY AND CREATE A NEGATIVE DYNAMIC.
