ORDER OF OPERATIONS (PEMDAS/BODMAS): THE RULES FOR EVALUATING MATHEMATICAL EXPRESSIONS (PARENTHESES/BRACKETS, EXPONENTS/ORDERS, MULTIPLICATION AND DIVISION, ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION).

2. GEOMETRY:

PLANE FIGURES: TWO-DIMENSIONAL SHAPES LIKE TRIANGLES, SQUARES, RECTANGLES, CIRCLES, AND POLYGONS.

SOLID FIGURES: THREE-DIMENSIONAL SHAPES LIKE CUBES, RECTANGULAR PRISMS, CYLINDERS, CONES, AND SPHERES.

AREA: THE AMOUNT OF SPACE INSIDE A TWO-DIMENSIONAL SHAPE.

PERIMETER: THE DISTANCE AROUND THE OUTSIDE OF A TWO-DIMENSIONAL SHAPE.

VOLUME: THE AMOUNT OF SPACE INSIDE A THREE-DIMENSIONAL SHAPE.

SURFACE AREA: THE TOTAL AREA OF ALL THE FACES OF A THREE-DIMENSIONAL SHAPE.

CONGRUENT: HAVING THE SAME SIZE AND SHAPE.

SIMILAR: HAVING THE SAME SHAPE BUT DIFFERENT SIZES.

3. ALGEBRA:

VARIABLE: A LETTER OR SYMBOL REPRESENTING AN UNKNOWN QUANTITY.

EXPRESSION: A MATHEMATICAL PHRASE CONTAINING NUMBERS, VARIABLES, AND OPERATIONS.

EQUATION: A MATHEMATICAL STATEMENT SHOWING THAT TWO EXPRESSIONS ARE EQUAL.

INEQUALITY: A MATHEMATICAL STATEMENT SHOWING THAT TWO EXPRESSIONS ARE NOT EQUAL ($>$, $<$, $\geq$, $\leq$).

SOLUTION: THE VALUE OF A VARIABLE THAT MAKES AN EQUATION OR INEQUALITY TRUE.

4. DATA ANALYSIS AND PROBABILITY:

MEAN: THE AVERAGE OF A SET OF NUMBERS.

MEDIAN: THE MIDDLE NUMBER IN A SET OF NUMBERS WHEN THEY ARE ORDERED.

MODE: THE NUMBER THAT APPEARS MOST FREQUENTLY IN A SET OF NUMBERS.

RANGE: THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE HIGHEST AND LOWEST NUMBERS IN A SET.

PROBABILITY: THE LIKELIHOOD OF AN EVENT OCCURRING.
