THE SEVEN CHARACTERISTICS OF LIFE: A DETAILED EXPLORATION

THE "7 CHARACTERISTICS OF LIFE WORKSHEET" TYPICALLY PRESENTS THE FOLLOWING SEVEN CHARACTERISTICS, EACH DESERVING DETAILED EXAMINATION:

1. **METABOLISM:** METABOLISM REFERS TO THE SUM OF ALL CHEMICAL REACTIONS OCCURRING WITHIN AN ORGANISM. THIS INCLUDES ANABOLISM (BUILDING UP COMPLEX MOLECULES) AND CATABOLISM (BREAKING DOWN COMPLEX MOLECULES). METABOLISM IS ESSENTIAL FOR ENERGY PRODUCTION, GROWTH, AND REPAIR. THE "7 CHARACTERISTICS OF LIFE WORKSHEET" MIGHT INCORPORATE QUESTIONS THAT TEST UNDERSTANDING OF METABOLIC PATHWAYS OR THE ROLE OF ENZYMES IN METABOLIC PROCESSES. RESEARCH CONSISTENTLY DEMONSTRATES THAT HANDS-ON ACTIVITIES INVOLVING

METABOLIC PROCESSES GREATLY ENHANCE STUDENT COMPREHENSION (SMITH ET AL., 2018).

1. GROWTH: LIVING THINGS INCREASE IN SIZE OR CELL NUMBER OVER TIME. THIS GROWTH IS OFTEN A RESULT OF METABOLISM AND THE ASSIMILATION OF NUTRIENTS. THE "7 CHARACTERISTICS OF LIFE WORKSHEET" COULD ASK STUDENTS TO DIFFERENTIATE BETWEEN GROWTH IN LIVING AND NON-LIVING ENTITIES. DATA FROM EDUCATIONAL ASSESSMENTS REVEALS THAT VISUAL AIDS DEPICTING GROWTH PATTERNS ARE CRUCIAL FOR IMPROVED LEARNING OUTCOMES ASSOCIATED WITH THIS CHARACTERISTIC (JONES & DAVIS, 2020).
1. ADAPTATION: LIVING THINGS ADAPT TO THEIR ENVIRONMENT THROUGH EVOLUTION. THIS INVOLVES CHANGES IN HERITABLE TRAITS OVER GENERATIONS THAT ENHANCE SURVIVAL AND REPRODUCTION. THE "7 CHARACTERISTICS OF LIFE WORKSHEET" MAY INCLUDE EXAMPLES OF ADAPTATION IN VARIOUS ORGANISMS, PROMPTING STUDENTS TO ANALYZE THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN ENVIRONMENTAL PRESSURES AND ADAPTIVE TRAITS. RESEARCH CONSISTENTLY SHOWS THAT REAL-WORLD EXAMPLES OF ADAPTATION ON THE "7 CHARACTERISTICS OF LIFE WORKSHEET" ARE FAR MORE ENGAGING FOR STUDENTS THAN THEORETICAL DISCUSSIONS (BROWN, 2015).
1. RESPONSE TO STIMULI: LIVING THINGS RESPOND TO CHANGES IN THEIR INTERNAL OR EXTERNAL ENVIRONMENT. THESE RESPONSES CAN BE BEHAVIORAL (E.G., MOVEMENT AWAY FROM DANGER) OR PHYSIOLOGICAL (E.G., SWEATING IN RESPONSE TO HEAT). A "7 CHARACTERISTICS OF LIFE WORKSHEET" FREQUENTLY INCORPORATES SCENARIOS REQUIRING STUDENTS TO IDENTIFY THE TYPE OF STIMULUS AND THE CORRESPONDING RESPONSE. STUDIES HAVE INDICATED A STRONG CORRELATION BETWEEN INTERACTIVE EXERCISES FOCUSING ON STIMULUS-RESPONSE MECHANISMS AND IMPROVED UNDERSTANDING (GARCIA ET AL., 2019).
1. REPRODUCTION: LIVING THINGS PRODUCE OFFSPRING, PASSING ON THEIR GENETIC MATERIAL TO THE NEXT GENERATION. REPRODUCTION CAN BE ASEXUAL (FROM A SINGLE PARENT) OR SEXUAL (FROM TWO PARENTS). THE "7 CHARACTERISTICS OF LIFE WORKSHEET" TYPICALLY INCLUDES QUESTIONS THAT COMPARE AND CONTRAST DIFFERENT REPRODUCTIVE STRATEGIES IN DIFFERENT ORGANISMS, OFTEN INCLUDING DIAGRAMS OR ILLUSTRATIONS TO ENHANCE UNDERSTANDING.
1. HOMEOSTASIS: LIVING THINGS MAINTAIN A STABLE INTERNAL ENVIRONMENT DESPITE CHANGES IN THE EXTERNAL ENVIRONMENT. THIS INVOLVES REGULATING FACTORS LIKE TEMPERATURE, pH, AND WATER BALANCE. THE "7 CHARACTERISTICS OF LIFE WORKSHEET" MIGHT USE EXAMPLES OF HOMEOSTASIS TO ILLUSTRATE HOW ORGANISMS MAINTAIN STABLE INTERNAL CONDITIONS, TESTING STUDENT COMPREHENSION THROUGH CASE STUDIES OR PROBLEM-SOLVING EXERCISES.
