CONSIDER JOURNALING YOUR PRAYERS BEFORE AND AFTER YOUR STUDY SESSION, NOTING THE INSIGHTS YOU RECEIVE AND THE AREAS WHERE YOU FEEL GOD'S LEADING.

1. CONTEXTUAL UNDERSTANDING:

DILIGENT RESEARCH INTO COMMENTARIES, BIBLE DICTIONARIES, AND HISTORICAL BACKGROUNDS SIGNIFICANTLY ENHANCES COMPREHENSION. THE 7 PILLARS OF BIBLE STUDY EMPHASIZE THIS CONTEXTUAL UNDERSTANDING AS FUNDAMENTAL.

1. OBSERVATION:

CAREFUL OBSERVATION IS THE BEDROCK OF GOOD INTERPRETATION. THIS PILLAR INVOLVES METICULOUSLY READING THE PASSAGE MULTIPLE TIMES, NOTING KEY WORDS, PHRASES, AND REPEATED THEMES. 1. APPLICATION:

1. MEDITATION & REFLECTION:

THIS PILLAR INVOLVES TAKING TIME TO PONDER AND REFLECT ON WHAT YOU'VE LEARNED. ALLOW THE PASSAGE TO SINK INTO YOUR HEART AND MIND. MEDITATE ON THE KEY THEMES AND PRINCIPLES. Volume 1 contains fourteen essays on twenty-two interpreters who were principally active before 1980, and volume 2 has nineteen essays on twenty-seven of those who were active primarily after this date. Each chapter provides a brief biography of one or more scholars, as well as a detailed description of their major contributions to the field. This is followed by an (often new) application of the scholar's theory. By focusing on the individual scholars and their work, the book recognizes that interpretive approaches arise out of certain circumstances, and that scholars are influenced by, and have influences upon, both other interpreters and the times in which they live. This set is ideal for any class on the history of biblical interpretation and for those who want a greater understanding of how the current field of biblical studies developed.
