SCIENTIFIC AND ENGINEERING PRACTICES: THESE FOCUS ON THE SKILLS STUDENTS NEED TO ENGAGE IN SCIENTIFIC INQUIRY AND ENGINEERING DESIGN, INCLUDING ASKING QUESTIONS, PLANNING AND CARRYING OUT INVESTIGATIONS, ANALYZING AND INTERPRETING DATA, CONSTRUCTING EXPLANATIONS, AND ENGAGING IN ARGUMENT FROM EVIDENCE. IN 7TH GRADE, THIS OFTEN INVOLVES DESIGNING EXPERIMENTS, ANALYZING DATA USING GRAPHS AND CHARTS, AND CONSTRUCTING SCIENTIFIC ARGUMENTS BASED ON EVIDENCE. EXAMPLES WITHIN THE 7TH GRADE SCIENCE STANDARDS CALIFORNIA INCLUDE DESIGNING AN EXPERIMENT TO TEST THE EFFECT OF A VARIABLE ON PLANT GROWTH OR ANALYZING DATA FROM A WEATHER EXPERIMENT TO SUPPORT A CLAIM ABOUT CLIMATE CHANGE.

DISCIPLINARY CORE IDEAS (DCIs): THESE ARE THE KEY CONCEPTS AND CONTENT WITHIN THE THREE MAIN SCIENCE DISCIPLINES: PHYSICAL SCIENCE, LIFE SCIENCE, AND EARTH AND SPACE SCIENCE. FOR 7TH GRADE IN CALIFORNIA, THESE DCIs ARE FOCUSED ON DEEPENING UNDERSTANDING OF:

PHYSICAL SCIENCE: THIS INCLUDES EXPLORING ENERGY TRANSFER, INCLUDING THE KINETIC THEORY OF MATTER, ENERGY TRANSFORMATION, AND WAVES. STUDENTS LEARN ABOUT THE PROPERTIES OF MATTER AND THE NATURE OF ENERGY, FOCUSING ON HOW ENERGY IS TRANSFERRED AND TRANSFORMED WITHIN SYSTEMS.

LIFE SCIENCE: THIS ENCOMPASSES AN UNDERSTANDING OF CELLS, HEREDITY, AND EVOLUTION. STUDENTS WILL EXPLORE THE STRUCTURE AND FUNCTION OF CELLS, THE PROCESSES OF CELL DIVISION, AND THE CONCEPTS OF HEREDITY AND INHERITANCE. THEY ALSO BEGIN TO UNDERSTAND THE MECHANISMS OF EVOLUTION, INCLUDING NATURAL SELECTION.

EARTH AND SPACE SCIENCE: THIS INVOLVES EXPLORING THE STRUCTURE OF THE EARTH SYSTEM, INCLUDING PLATE TECTONICS, EARTHQUAKES, AND VOLCANOES. STUDENTS INVESTIGATE THE EARTH'S SYSTEMS AND THEIR INTERACTIONS, INCLUDING THE ROCK CYCLE, PLATE TECTONICS, AND THE PROCESSES SHAPING EARTH'S SURFACE. THEY ALSO LEARN ABOUT THE SOLAR SYSTEM AND THE UNIVERSE.

CROSSCUTTING CONCEPTS: THESE CONNECT THE DCIs ACROSS DIFFERENT DISCIPLINES AND PROVIDE A FRAMEWORK FOR UNDERSTANDING SCIENTIFIC PHENOMENA. EXAMPLES IN 7TH-GRADE SCIENCE STANDARDS CALIFORNIA INCLUDE CAUSE AND EFFECT, PATTERNS, SCALE, PROPORTION, AND QUANTITY, SYSTEMS AND SYSTEM MODELS, ENERGY AND MATTER, STRUCTURE AND FUNCTION. STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO USE THESE CROSSCUTTING CONCEPTS TO ANALYZE DATA, CONSTRUCT EXPLANATIONS, AND BUILD MODELS.

1. METHODOLOGIES AND APPROACHES IN 7TH GRADE SCIENCE INSTRUCTION:

EFFECTIVE TEACHING OF THE 7TH GRADE SCIENCE STANDARDS CALIFORNIA REQUIRES A VARIETY OF METHODOLOGIES, EMPHASIZING HANDS-ON, INQUIRY-BASED LEARNING:

INQUIRY-BASED LEARNING: STUDENTS ACTIVELY INVESTIGATE SCIENTIFIC QUESTIONS, DESIGN EXPERIMENTS, COLLECT DATA, AND DRAW CONCLUSIONS. THIS FOSTERS CRITICAL THINKING AND PROBLEM-SOLVING SKILLS. THE 7TH GRADE SCIENCE STANDARDS CALIFORNIA ENCOURAGES THIS APPROACH THROUGH PROJECTS AND EXPERIMENTS THAT REQUIRE STUDENTS TO DEVELOP THEIR OWN HYPOTHESES AND TEST THEM USING SCIENTIFIC METHODS.

HANDS-ON ACTIVITIES AND EXPERIMENTS: DIRECT ENGAGEMENT WITH SCIENTIFIC MATERIALS AND PROCESSES IS CRUCIAL. BUILDING MODELS, CONDUCTING EXPERIMENTS, AND MAKING OBSERVATIONS HELPS TO SOLIDIFY UNDERSTANDING OF ABSTRACT CONCEPTS.

TECHNOLOGY INTEGRATION: INTERACTIVE SIMULATIONS, ONLINE RESOURCES, AND DATA ANALYSIS SOFTWARE CAN ENHANCE LEARNING AND ENGAGE STUDENTS. THE USE OF TECHNOLOGY CAN EXPAND ACCESS TO DATA AND SIMULATIONS, ALLOWING STUDENTS TO EXPLORE COMPLEX SYSTEMS AND CONDUCT VIRTUAL EXPERIMENTS.

COLLABORATIVE LEARNING: GROUP PROJECTS AND DISCUSSIONS ENCOURAGE TEAMWORK, COMMUNICATION, AND PEER LEARNING. THIS APPROACH REFLECTS REAL-WORLD SCIENTIFIC COLLABORATIONS AND DEVELOPS VITAL COMMUNICATION SKILLS.

Experiences and contributions of ethnic groups and women in history are integrated in this course model.
