THE RISE OF MULTICULTURALISM AND GLOBAL AWARENESS HAS FURTHER SHAPED THE CONTENT, LEADING TO A GREATER EMPHASIS ON GLOBAL INTERCONNECTEDNESS AND THE INCLUSION OF NON-WESTERN PERSPECTIVES IN THE 7TH GRADE SOCIAL STUDIES TEXTBOOK.
