THEMATIC APPROACHES: ORGANIZING CONTENT AROUND OVERARCHING THEMES, SUCH AS MIGRATION, EMPIRE, REVOLUTION, OR ENVIRONMENTAL CHANGE, CAN PROVIDE A MORE COHERENT AND ENGAGING LEARNING EXPERIENCE.

INQUIRY-BASED LEARNING: EMPOWERING STUDENTS TO ASK THEIR OWN QUESTIONS AND PURSUE THEIR OWN LINES OF INQUIRY CAN FOSTER DEEPER ENGAGEMENT AND CRITICAL THINKING.

CULTURALLY RESPONSIVE PEDAGOGY: CREATING LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS THAT ACKNOWLEDGE AND VALUE THE DIVERSE BACKGROUNDS AND EXPERIENCES OF ALL STUDENTS.
