THIS PROCESS REQUIRES EMPATHY, UNDERSTANDING, AND A COMMITMENT TO HEALING.

H7: CELEBRATING SUCCESSES AND SUPPORTING EACH OTHER THROUGH CHALLENGES

FAMILY LIFE IS A JOURNEY FILLED WITH BOTH TRIUMPHS AND SETBACKS. CELEBRATE SUCCESSES, BOTH BIG AND SMALL, TO REINFORCE POSITIVE FEELINGS AND ENCOURAGE CONTINUED GROWTH. EQUALLY IMPORTANT IS PROVIDING UNWAVERING SUPPORT DURING CHALLENGING TIMES. BE THERE FOR EACH OTHER, OFFERING COMFORT, ENCOURAGEMENT, AND PRACTICAL ASSISTANCE. THIS MUTUAL SUPPORT SYSTEM IS VITAL TO NAVIGATING LIFE'S INEVITABLE DIFFICULTIES.

H8: MAINTAINING HEALTHY BOUNDARIES: RESPECTING INDIVIDUAL SPACE AND NEEDS
