ADDRESSING BURNOUT AND MENTAL HEALTH: RECOGNIZING THE HIGH RATES OF BURNOUT AND MENTAL HEALTH CHALLENGES AMONG HEALTHCARE WORKERS, THE HANDBOOK MIGHT INCLUDE PROVISIONS FOR MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT SERVICES, ACCESS TO COUNSELING, AND INITIATIVES TO PROMOTE A HEALTHIER WORK-LIFE BALANCE.

INCREASED FOCUS ON WORKPLACE EQUITY AND INCLUSION: THE 1199 UNION HAS BEEN A VOCAL ADVOCATE FOR DIVERSITY, EQUITY, AND INCLUSION WITHIN THE HEALTHCARE SECTOR.
