GAIT: ASSESS THE PATIENT'S GAIT FOR SMOOTHNESS, RHYTHM, AND BALANCE. A NORMAL GAIT IS CHARACTERIZED BY A STEADY PACE, EVEN WEIGHT DISTRIBUTION, AND COORDINATED MOVEMENTS. LIMPING, SHUFFLING, OR UNSTEADY GAIT MAY INDICATE

UNDERLYING MUSCULOSKELETAL ISSUES. A NORMAL ASSESSMENT FINDING OF THE MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM IS A STEADY AND BALANCED GAIT.

2.2 RANGE OF MOTION (ROM):

A NORMAL ASSESSMENT FINDING OF THE MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM IS A FULL AND PAIN-FREE RANGE OF MOTION IN ALL MAJOR JOINTS. ASSESS ROM PASSIVELY AND ACTIVELY FOR EACH JOINT (E.G., FLEXION, EXTENSION, ABDUCTION, ADDUCTION, ROTATION). COMPARE ROM BILATERALLY; SLIGHT ASYMMETRIES ARE OFTEN NORMAL, BUT SIGNIFICANT DIFFERENCES WARRANT FURTHER INVESTIGATION. USE A GONIOMETER FOR OBJECTIVE MEASUREMENT WHEN NEEDED. NOTE ANY PAIN, CREPITUS (GRATING SOUND), OR LIMITATIONS IN MOVEMENT.

2.3 MUSCLE STRENGTH ASSESSMENT:

MUSCLE STRENGTH IS ASSESSED USING A STANDARDIZED GRADING SYSTEM (E.G., 0-5 SCALE). A NORMAL ASSESSMENT FINDING OF THE MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM INCLUDES THE ABILITY TO PERFORM MOVEMENTS AGAINST GRAVITY AND RESISTANCE WITH NORMAL STRENGTH FOR AGE AND ACTIVITY LEVELS. ASSESS MAJOR MUSCLE GROUPS BILATERALLY. WEAKNESS OR ASYMMETRY INDICATES POTENTIAL NEUROLOGICAL OR MUSCULOSKELETAL PROBLEMS.

2.4 PALPATION:

PALPATE BONES, JOINTS, AND MUSCLES FOR TENDERNESS, SWELLING, WARMTH, OR MASSES. A NORMAL ASSESSMENT FINDING OF THE MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM IS THE ABSENCE OF TENDERNESS, SWELLING, AND ABNORMAL MASSES. NOTE ANY UNUSUAL TEMPERATURE VARIATIONS.

2.5 BONE STRUCTURE ASSESSMENT:

A NORMAL ASSESSMENT FINDING OF THE MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM INCLUDES THE NORMAL BONY STRUCTURES AND ALIGNMENT. ASSESS FOR DEFORMITIES, SWELLING, OR ASYMMETRY. PALPATION CAN HELP IDENTIFY BONY PROMINENCES AND THEIR ALIGNMENT. IMAGING STUDIES (X-RAYS, CT SCANS, MRI) MAY BE NEEDED FOR MORE DETAILED ASSESSMENT.

1. NORMAL VARIATIONS BASED ON AGE AND ACTIVITY LEVEL

A NORMAL ASSESSMENT FINDING OF THE MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM CAN VARY WITH AGE AND ACTIVITY LEVEL.
