A Solution with a pH of 7 Is: Understanding Neutrality in Chemistry and Its Significance

It is important to note that the pH of pure water is only exactly 7 at 25°C. The autoionization constant of water (K_w) is temperature-dependent, meaning that the pH of pure water will vary slightly with temperature changes.
