¹⁶10, and (b) the records of ¹⁴10 cosmogenic isotopes, such as ¹⁴C and ¹⁰Be, measured in tree-rings and ice cores, respectively. The study of the long-term behaviour of solar activity may be complemented by the study of historical accounts describing phenomena directly or indirectly related to solar activity. Numerous scientific and non-scientific documents have reported these events and we can make use of them as a proxy of solar activity in past times.
