ANALYZING THE TONE AND CONTEXT OF HIS HUMOR IS CRUCIAL FOR UNDERSTANDING THE TRUE MESSAGE.

CONTROLLED NARRATIVE: RODGERS CAREFULLY CRAFTS HIS NARRATIVES TO SHAPE PUBLIC PERCEPTION. HE MAY HIGHLIGHT INDIVIDUAL OR TEAM SUCCESSES, SUBTLY DOWNPLAY FAILURES, OR EMPHASIZE SPECIFIC THEMES TO CONTROL THE OVERALL MESSAGE COMMUNICATED IN THE AARON RODGERS POSTGAME INTERVIEW. ANALYZING THE FLOW OF INFORMATION AND THE SELECTION OF DETAILS PROVIDES INSIGHT INTO HIS STRATEGIC GOALS.
