This experience underscored the crucial need for accurate and detailed observation and the value of regularly reviewing ABC data to ensure its accuracy and consistency.

While the basic ABC recording format is straightforward, several refinements can enhance its effectiveness. These include:

Operational Definitions: Clearly defining the target behavior and the antecedents and consequences avoids ambiguity.

Data Analysis: Analyzing the collected data to identify patterns and trends is crucial for informing intervention strategies.
