SIMPLY PRACTICING FORMING LETTERS ON "ABC WRITING PRACTICE SHEETS" DOES NOT GUARANTEE AN UNDERSTANDING OF THEIR SOUNDS OR THEIR USE IN WORDS AND SENTENCES.

3. THE ROLE OF TECHNOLOGY IN ENHANCING ABC WRITING PRACTICE SHEETS

THE INTEGRATION OF TECHNOLOGY OFFERS EXCITING POSSIBILITIES FOR ENHANCING THE EFFECTIVENESS OF "ABC WRITING PRACTICE SHEETS." THE USE OF INTERACTIVE WHITEBOARDS AND OTHER TECHNOLOGY CAN FURTHER ENHANCE THIS PROCESS BY MAKING LEARNING MORE DYNAMIC AND ENGAGING.

5. THE IMPORTANCE OF CONTEXT AND MEANING IN ABC WRITING PRACTICE SHEETS
