H2: CORE COURSES IN THE UCLA ACCOUNTING MINOR:

AUDITING: THIS COURSE PROVIDES AN OVERVIEW OF THE AUDITING PROCESS, COVERING BOTH INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL AUDITS.

THESE CORE COURSES PROVIDE A SOLID FOUNDATION IN ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES AND TECHNIQUES, PREPARING STUDENTS FOR MORE SPECIALIZED COURSEWORK AND FUTURE CAREER OPPORTUNITIES.

H3: ELECTIVE COURSES AND CUSTOMIZATION OPTIONS:

IN ADDITION TO THE CORE COURSES, THE ACCOUNTING MINOR UCLA REQUIREMENTS TYPICALLY ALLOW FOR ELECTIVE COURSES, ENABLING STUDENTS TO TAILOR THEIR PROGRAM TO THEIR SPECIFIC INTERESTS.
