## ACETYL CYSTEINE 20 INHALATION SOLUTION: A COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW

### 2. MECHANISM OF ACTION OF ACETYL CYSTEINE 20 INHALATION SOLUTION

## 4. EFFICACY AND SAFETY PROFILE OF ACETYL CYSTEINE 20 INHALATION SOLUTION

NUMEROUS CLINICAL TRIALS HAVE EVALUATED THE EFFICACY OF ACETYL CYSTEINE 20 INHALATION SOLUTION IN VARIOUS RESPIRATORY CONDITIONS. COMPARATIVE STUDIES ARE NEEDED TO DEFINITELY ESTABLISH SUPERIORITY AMONG THESE AGENTS FOR SPECIFIC RESPIRATORY CONDITIONS (CITE RELEVANT COMPARATIVE STUDIES, IF AVAILABLE).
