### H1: Understanding the Basics of Compression

This "acoustic guitar compression cheat sheet" provides starting points; always listen critically and adjust to your specific needs.

### Scenario 1: Gentle Compression for Natural Sound

Ratio: 1.5:1 – 2:1

Threshold: -18dBFS to -12dBFS (adjust based on peak levels)

Attack: 20-50ms

Release: 200-500ms

Makeup Gain: Minimal to moderate.

This setting aims to tame occasional peaks while preserving the natural dynamics of the acoustic guitar. Ideal for fingerpicking styles and recordings prioritizing a delicate, intimate feel.

### Scenario 2: Moderate Compression for Balanced Sound

Ratio: 2:1 – 3:1

Threshold: -15dBFS to -10dBFS

Attack: 10-30ms

Release: 100-300ms

Makeup Gain: Moderate.

This balances the dynamics, making the quieter notes more prominent without significantly altering the character of the instrument. Suitable for various playing styles, including strumming and fingerpicking.

### Scenario 3: Aggressive Compression for Powerful Sound

Ratio: 4:1 – 6:1

Threshold: -10dBFS to -5dBFS

Attack: 5-15ms

Release: 50-150ms

Makeup Gain: Significant.

This is for creating a consistent, powerful sound; often used for lead acoustic guitar parts that require a more

prominent presence in the mix. Use cautiously, as excessive compression can lead to a lifeless, "squashed" sound. This "acoustic guitar compression cheat sheet" reminds you to use this sparingly!

### H3: Advanced Techniques

**Sidechaining:** Use a bass or kick drum to trigger the compressor, ducking the acoustic guitar slightly on the beat. This creates space in the mix and adds rhythmic interest.

**Parallel Compression:** Send a copy of the acoustic guitar signal to a heavily compressed aux track, then blend it with the clean signal to add punch and sustain.

**Multiband Compression:** Use a multiband compressor to apply different compression settings to different frequency ranges of the guitar, allowing for more precise control.
