A CONTINUOUS EVALUATION AND REFINEMENT OF THE ACT MATH GRADING

SCALE IS NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN ITS RELEVANCE AND VALIDITY IN THE EVOLVING EDUCATIONAL LANDSCAPE.
