ITS ROOTS LIE IN THE SHIFT FROM PREDOMINANTLY PASSIVE MODALITIES (LIKE ULTRASOUND OR ELECTRICAL STIMULATION) TOWARDS ACTIVE INTERVENTIONS THAT DIRECTLY ENGAGE THE PATIENT IN THEIR OWN RECOVERY.

THIS SHIFT GAINED MOMENTUM IN THE LATE 20TH CENTURY, COINCIDING WITH ADVANCES IN OUR UNDERSTANDING OF MUSCULOSKELETAL BIOMECHANICS AND THE INCREASING EMPHASIS ON EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICE. EARLY PIONEERS IN THIS APPROACH FOCUSED ON FUNCTIONAL TRAINING, EMPHASIZING MOVEMENTS RELEVANT TO THE PATIENT'S DAILY LIFE. THIS CONTRASTS WITH OLDER, MORE PASSIVE APPROACHES THAT MAY HAVE PRIORITIZED ISOLATED MUSCLE STRENGTHENING WITHOUT SUFFICIENT ATTENTION TO FUNCTIONAL INTEGRATION. THE "ACTION JACKSON" PHILOSOPHY, THEREFORE, IS INTRINSICALLY LINKED TO THIS PARADIGM SHIFT – A MOVE TOWARDS EMPOWERING PATIENTS TO ACTIVELY PARTICIPATE IN THEIR HEALING JOURNEY.

2. CORE PRINCIPLES OF ACTION JACKSON PHYSICAL THERAPY

WHILE NOT FORMALLY DEFINED, THE ESSENCE OF "ACTION JACKSON PHYSICAL THERAPY" REVOLVES AROUND SEVERAL KEY PRINCIPLES:

PATIENT-CENTERED CARE: THE PATIENT'S INDIVIDUAL NEEDS, GOALS, AND PREFERENCES ARE CENTRAL TO THE TREATMENT PLAN.

ACTIVE PARTICIPATION: PATIENTS ARE ACTIVELY INVOLVED IN EVERY STAGE OF THEIR REHABILITATION, FROM ASSESSMENT TO EXERCISE IMPLEMENTATION.

FUNCTIONAL TRAINING: EXERCISES FOCUS ON RESTORING FUNCTIONAL MOVEMENTS NECESSARY FOR DAILY ACTIVITIES, WORK, AND LEISURE.

PROGRESSIVE OVERLOAD: GRADUAL INCREASES IN THE INTENSITY AND COMPLEXITY OF EXERCISES CHALLENGE THE BODY TO ADAPT AND STRENGTHEN.

HOLISTIC APPROACH: TREATMENT CONSIDERS THE WHOLE PERSON – PHYSICAL, EMOTIONAL, AND PSYCHOLOGICAL FACTORS – IMPACTING RECOVERY.

MEASURABLE OUTCOMES: PROGRESS IS TRACKED AND MEASURED USING OBJECTIVE ASSESSMENTS TO MONITOR EFFECTIVENESS AND ADJUST THE TREATMENT PLAN ACCORDINGLY.

3. CURRENT RELEVANCE OF ACTION JACKSON PHYSICAL THERAPY IN MODERN PRACTICE

THE PRINCIPLES UNDERLYING "ACTION JACKSON PHYSICAL THERAPY" REMAIN HIGHLY RELEVANT IN MODERN PHYSICAL THERAPY. "ACTION JACKSON PHYSICAL THERAPY," WITH ITS FOCUS ON FUNCTIONAL IMPROVEMENT AND PATIENT ENGAGEMENT, PROVIDES A ROBUST FRAMEWORK FOR MANAGING THESE CONDITIONS. MOREOVER, ADVANCEMENTS IN TECHNOLOGY, SUCH AS WEARABLE SENSORS AND VIRTUAL REALITY, CAN BE SEAMLESSLY INTEGRATED INTO THIS APPROACH, ENHANCING PATIENT MOTIVATION AND PROVIDING REAL-TIME FEEDBACK.

4. CHALLENGES AND FUTURE DIRECTIONS

DESPITE ITS RELEVANCE, "ACTION JACKSON PHYSICAL THERAPY" FACES CERTAIN CHALLENGES. THE INCREASING DEMANDS OF HEALTHCARE SYSTEMS OFTEN NECESSITATE SHORTER TREATMENT DURATIONS, POTENTIALLY LIMITING THE TIME AVAILABLE FOR COMPREHENSIVE FUNCTIONAL TRAINING. The aim of this research topic is to clarify the underlying mechanisms of mental practice, bringing evidence from cognitive neuroscience, experimental neuropsychology, sport and movement science, and clinical neurology. It also attempts to address confusion regarding the concepts of imagery and observation, which has hampered the progression of mental practice research both scientifically and applied. As well as reviews, theoretical, and position articles, this research topic includes original neuroimaging, experimental, and patient research addressing, among others, the following issues. Neuroimaging studies provide strong evidence for action simulation, but the link to behavioural change and functional outcome is weak. What is the evidence that mental practice efficacy is driven

by neuroplasticity processes evoked by action simulation? This research topic includes contributions on neural correlates and behaviour with regards to imagery and action observation. Much of the mental practice efficacy evidence comes from longstanding research within sport science. However, what does mental practice entail in these contexts, and to what extent is it compatible with the cognitive neuroscience perspective of action simulation? This research topic will include contributions that consider both evidence and concepts with regards to imagery and action observation, in an attempt to build an interdisciplinary consensus on the nature and application of mental practice.
