A. HEADLINE AND KEY MESSAGING:

THE HEADLINE SHOULD BE ATTENTION-GRABBING AND IMMEDIATELY COMMUNICATE THE FLYER'S PURPOSE. AVOID JARGON; USE CLEAR, CONCISE LANGUAGE THAT EVERYONE CAN UNDERSTAND. FOR EXAMPLE, INSTEAD OF "UNDERSTANDING ACTIVE THREAT RESPONSE PROTOCOLS," USE "STAY SAFE: ACTIVE SHOOTER PREPAREDNESS TRAINING."

KEY MESSAGES SHOULD BE BULLET-POINTED OR CLEARLY SEPARATED FOR EASY READABILITY. FOCUS ON ACTIONABLE STEPS INDIVIDUALS CAN TAKE TO INCREASE THEIR CHANCES OF SURVIVAL.

B. VISUAL APPEAL:

USE HIGH-QUALITY IMAGES AND GRAPHICS. AVOID CLUTTERED DESIGNS. A VISUALLY APPEALING FLYER IS MORE LIKELY TO BE NOTICED AND READ. CONSIDER USING A COLOR SCHEME THAT EVOKES A SENSE OF URGENCY AND SERIOUSNESS WITHOUT BEING OVERLY ALARMING. INCORPORATE YOUR COMPANY LOGO SUBTLY TO MAINTAIN BRAND CONSISTENCY.

C. CALL TO ACTION:

EVERY ACTIVE SHOOTER TRAINING FLYER NEEDS A CLEAR CALL TO ACTION. TELL THE AUDIENCE WHAT YOU WANT THEM TO DO NEXT. THIS MIGHT INCLUDE REGISTERING FOR A TRAINING SESSION, VISITING A WEBSITE FOR MORE INFORMATION, OR CONTACTING A SPECIFIC PERSON OR DEPARTMENT.

D. CONTACT INFORMATION:

INCLUDE CONTACT INFORMATION FOR QUESTIONS OR FURTHER INQUIRIES. PROVIDE MULTIPLE CONTACT METHODS (PHONE, EMAIL, WEBSITE) TO ENSURE ACCESSIBILITY.

II. COMMON PITFALLS TO AVOID

MANY COMMON MISTAKES CAN HINDER THE EFFECTIVENESS OF AN ACTIVE SHOOTER TRAINING FLYER. AVOIDING THESE PITFALLS IS CRITICAL.

A. OVERWHELMING INFORMATION:

AVOID OVERWHELMING THE READER WITH TOO MUCH TEXT. KEEP IT CONCISE AND FOCUS ON THE MOST CRUCIAL INFORMATION. PROVIDE LINKS TO ADDITIONAL RESOURCES FOR THOSE SEEKING MORE IN-DEPTH KNOWLEDGE.

B. POOR DESIGN AND LAYOUT:

A POORLY DESIGNED FLYER WILL LIKELY BE IGNORED. PRIORITIZE CLEAR TYPOGRAPHY, APPROPRIATE SPACING, AND A BALANCED LAYOUT FOR OPTIMAL READABILITY. ENSURE THE FLYER IS ACCESSIBLE TO INDIVIDUALS WITH VISUAL IMPAIRMENTS.

C. LACK OF A CLEAR CALL TO ACTION:

WITHOUT A CLEAR CALL TO ACTION, THE FLYER WILL FAIL TO ACHIEVE ITS PURPOSE. ENSURE READERS KNOW PRECISELY WHAT STEPS TO TAKE NEXT.

D. INCONSISTENT BRANDING:

MAINTAIN CONSISTENT BRANDING THROUGHOUT THE FLYER TO ENSURE IT ALIGNS WITH YOUR ORGANIZATION'S OVERALL IMAGE.

III. DISTRIBUTING YOUR ACTIVE SHOOTER TRAINING FLYER

EFFECTIVE DISTRIBUTION IS JUST AS IMPORTANT AS EFFECTIVE DESIGN. A WELL-CRAFTED FLYER IS USELESS IF IT DOESN'T REACH THE INTENDED AUDIENCE.

A. TARGET AUDIENCE:

IDENTIFY YOUR TARGET AUDIENCE AND CHOOSE DISTRIBUTION CHANNELS THAT WILL REACH THEM EFFECTIVELY. CONSIDER FACTORS SUCH AS AGE, TECHNOLOGICAL LITERACY, AND PREFERRED COMMUNICATION METHODS.

B. DISTRIBUTION CHANNELS:

USE A MULTI-CHANNEL APPROACH. THIS MAY INCLUDE POSTING FLYERS IN HIGH-TRAFFIC AREAS (BREAK ROOMS, HALLWAYS, ENTRANCES), DISTRIBUTING THEM ELECTRONICALLY VIA EMAIL, OR UTILIZING INTERNAL COMMUNICATION PLATFORMS.

C. TIMING:

CONSIDER THE TIMING OF YOUR DISTRIBUTION. DISTRIBUTE THE ACTIVE SHOOTER TRAINING FLYER IN ADVANCE OF A SCHEDULED TRAINING SESSION OR DURING A RELEVANT SAFETY AWARENESS CAMPAIGN.

D. Follow Up:

FOLLOW UP ON YOUR DISTRIBUTION EFFORTS TO ENSURE THE MESSAGE IS RECEIVED AND UNDERSTOOD.

IV. CONCLUSION

CREATING AN EFFECTIVE ACTIVE SHOOTER TRAINING FLYER REQUIRES CAREFUL PLANNING, DESIGN, AND DISTRIBUTION. For this Guide, we will focus on Points of Distribution or PODs. PODs can accommodate vehicle traffic (drive-thru), pedestrian traffic (walk thru), and mass transit traffic (bus or rail). Each person or vehicle receives a set amount of supplies. The recommended amount is for each person/vehicle to receive enough for a household of three. The amount of supplies provided will differ depending on the type of transportation used. For instance, more supplies are provided to someone in a car than to a pedestrian who must hand carry items.
