THIS SITUATION UNDERSCORES A COMMON CHALLENGE FOR RAPIDLY EXPANDING ORGANIZATIONS: MAINTAINING EFFECTIVE INTERNAL SYSTEMS AND ENSURING EQUITABLE RESOURCE DISTRIBUTION. RESEARCH INTO SIMILAR SOCIAL STRUCTURES IN FIRST-CENTURY JUDEA SUPPORTS THE PLAUSIBILITY OF THIS SCENARIO, SHOWING THAT COMMUNAL CARE SYSTEMS, WHILE OFTEN EFFECTIVE, WERE VULNERABLE TO INEFFICIENCIES UNDER PRESSURE.

THE SOLUTION: APPOINTING DEACONS

THE APOSTLES’ RESPONSE TO THE PROBLEM IS PIVOTAL. INSTEAD OF ASSUMING MORE ADMINISTRATIVE BURDENS THEMSELVES, THEY ADDRESS THE ISSUE BY DELEGATING RESPONSIBILITIES. THEY CALL FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF SEVEN MEN, “FULL OF THE SPIRIT AND WISDOM,” TO OVERSEE THE DISTRIBUTION OF FOOD. THIS ACT REPRESENTS A SIGNIFICANT STEP IN THE CHURCH’S ORGANIZATIONAL DEVELOPMENT, MARKING A DIVISION OF LABOR BETWEEN APOSTOLIC MINISTRY (FOCUSED ON TEACHING AND PRAYER) AND DIACONAL MINISTRY (FOCUSED ON SERVICE AND PRACTICAL NEEDS). THIS SOLUTION TO THE ISSUES IN ACTS CHAPTER 6 QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS FORMS A FOUNDATIONAL MODEL FOR CHURCH GOVERNANCE.

THE SEVEN DEACONS: THEIR ROLES AND SIGNIFICANCE

Seriously Wrong means there is NO eternal value in these religions. These belief systems were the fabrication of men and/or women and did NOT come from God. The evidence is overwhelming and deceit runs through these religions like vultures going through a carcass. You do not need a forensic analysis, but you can do a complete autopsy if you wish. The damaging evidence regarding these groups is clearly seen and very logical and understandable from the book. This is because AS YOU UNDERSTAND GOD (a significant subject in the book) you do not need to go very far into these beliefs to see huge problems.
