$$4.7 \times 10^3 + 0.82 \times 10^3 = (4.7 + 0.82) \times 10^3 = 5.52 \times 10^3$$

Subtraction follows a similar process:

Example 3: Subtract 1.8×10^{-2} from 5.2×10^{-2} .

$$5.2 \times 10^{-2} - 1.8 \times 10^{-2} = (5.2 - 1.8) \times 10^{-2} = 3.4 \times 10^{-2}$$

Example 4: Subtract 3.5×10^5 from 7.1×10^6 .

First, we need to adjust one number to match the exponent:

$$3.5 \times 10^5 = 0.35 \times 10^6$$

Now we subtract:

$$7.1 \times 10^6 - 0.35 \times 10^6 = (7.1 - 0.35) \times 10^6 = 6.75 \times 10^6$$
