The ones column ($5 + 8 = 13$) results in a number greater than 9. We regroup the 10 from the 13, carrying the '1' to the tens column, and the '3' remains in the ones column. The tens column becomes ($1 + 4 + 3 = 8$). The final answer is 83.

Similarly, in subtraction:

$$62 - 27 = ?$$

In the ones column, we can't subtract 7 from 2. We regroup by borrowing 1 ten from the tens column, making the 2 in the ones column 12. Now we subtract 7 from 12 ($12 - 7 = 5$). The tens column becomes ($5 - 2 = 3$). The final answer is 35.
