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UNDERSTANDING ADJACENT AND VERTICAL ANGLES

1. ADJACENT ANGLES: ADJACENT ANGLES ARE ANGLES THAT SHARE A COMMON VERTEX AND A COMMON SIDE, BUT DO NOT OVERLAP. THEY ARE "NEXT TO" EACH OTHER. CONSIDER TWO ANGLES, $\angle AOB$ AND $\angle BOC$, SHARING THE COMMON VERTEX O AND THE COMMON SIDE OB . THESE ARE ADJACENT ANGLES. IT'S IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT ADJACENT ANGLES DO NOT NECESSARILY ADD UP TO ANY SPECIFIC SUM.
1. VERTICAL ANGLES: VERTICAL ANGLES ARE THE ANGLES OPPOSITE EACH OTHER WHEN TWO LINES INTERSECT. THEY ARE FORMED BY TWO INTERSECTING LINES AND ARE ALWAYS CONGRUENT (EQUAL IN MEASURE). WHEN LINES AB AND CD INTERSECT AT POINT O , $\angle AOC$ AND $\angle BOD$ ARE VERTICAL ANGLES, AS ARE $\angle AOD$ AND $\angle BOC$. THIS PROPERTY, THAT VERTICAL ANGLES ARE CONGRUENT, IS A FUNDAMENTAL THEOREM IN GEOMETRY, FREQUENTLY UTILIZED IN PROBLEM-SOLVING.

UTILIZING AN ADJACENT AND VERTICAL ANGLES WORKSHEET

AN "ADJACENT AND VERTICAL ANGLES WORKSHEET" IS AN INVALUABLE TOOL FOR REINFORCING THESE CONCEPTS. CALCULATING UNKNOWN ANGLES: STUDENTS ARE GIVEN THE MEASURE OF ONE OR MORE ANGLES IN A DIAGRAM AND ASKED TO FIND THE MEASURES OF OTHER ADJACENT OR VERTICAL ANGLES USING THE PROPERTIES OF ADJACENT AND VERTICAL ANGLES (E.G., VERTICAL ANGLES ARE CONGRUENT, SUPPLEMENTARY ADJACENT ANGLES ADD UP TO 180 DEGREES). THIS SECTION OFTEN INCORPORATES ALGEBRAIC EQUATIONS, REQUIRING STUDENTS TO SOLVE FOR UNKNOWN VARIABLES.

CREATING AN EFFECTIVE ADJACENT AND VERTICAL ANGLES WORKSHEET

EXAMPLE 2 (INTERMEDIATE):

IN THE GIVEN DIAGRAM, $\angle AOB = 70^\circ$. FIND THE MEASURE OF $\angle BOC$, $\angle COD$, AND $\angle DOA$. (DIAGRAM SHOWING TWO INTERSECTING LINES WITH ONE ANGLE LABELED).

EXAMPLE 3 (ADVANCED):

TWO LINES INTERSECT, FORMING FOUR ANGLES. ONE ANGLE IS TWICE THE MEASURE OF ANOTHER. FIND THE MEASURE OF ALL FOUR ANGLES.
