FINANCIAL LITERACY EDUCATION: PROVIDING WORKSHOPS, ONLINE RESOURCES, AND ONE-ON-ONE COACHING TO EQUIP INDIVIDUALS WITH ESSENTIAL FINANCIAL SKILLS.

ASSET BUILDING: SUPPORTING STRATEGIES LIKE SAVINGS PLANS, HOMEOWNERSHIP INITIATIVES, AND RETIREMENT PLANNING TO HELP INDIVIDUALS ACCUMULATE WEALTH.
