THIS REQUIRES ASSESSMENT OF CLINICAL REASONING SKILLS, A MORE COMPLEX TASK THAN SIMPLY IDENTIFYING PHYSICAL SIGNS.

TECHNOLOGY INTEGRATION: THE USE OF TECHNOLOGY, SUCH AS ELECTRONIC STETHOSCOPES AND DIGITAL IMAGING, CAN ENHANCE ASSESSMENT, BUT INTEGRATION INTO THE 'ADVANCED HEALTH ASSESSMENT EXAM 1' REQUIRES CAREFUL CONSIDERATION.
