BASED ON A CHILD'S MATURITY LEVEL.

MATURE THEMES:

OPEN COMMUNICATION: TALKING TO CHILDREN ABOUT THE SHOW'S CONTENT ALLOWS PARENTS TO ADDRESS ANY CONCERNS OR QUESTIONS.

UTILIZING PARENTAL CONTROLS: STREAMING SERVICES OFFER PARENTAL CONTROLS THAT CAN LIMIT ACCESS TO CERTAIN CONTENT OR RESTRICT VIEWING TIMES.
