EARLY VERSIONS FOCUSED ON SIMPLER CALCULATIONS, WHILE SUBSEQUENT ITERATIONS INCORPORATED INCREASINGLY SOPHISTICATED COMPUTATIONAL METHODS AND CONSIDERED FACTORS LIKE INSULATION VALUES, WINDOW TYPES, AND APPLIANCE HEAT GAINS THAT WERE PREVIOUSLY NEGLECTED.
