DIFFERENTIATED INSTRUCTION: CATER TO DIVERSE LEARNING STYLES AND NEEDS BY PROVIDING DIFFERENTIATED INSTRUCTION AND SUPPORT.

COLLABORATIVE LEARNING: ENCOURAGE COLLABORATIVE LEARNING THROUGH GROUP WORK AND PEER-TO-PEER LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES.

FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT: REGULARLY ASSESS STUDENT UNDERSTANDING THROUGH FORMATIVE ASSESSMENTS TO IDENTIFY AREAS NEEDING FURTHER ATTENTION.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT: ENGAGE IN ONGOING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT TO STAY CURRENT WITH BEST PRACTICES AND RESOURCES RELATED TO THE ALABAMA MATH STANDARDS 2023.

COMMON PITFALLS TO AVOID WHEN IMPLEMENTING THE ALABAMA MATH STANDARDS 2023
