ANNUAL WMA LICENSE: THIS PROVIDES ACCESS TO ALL ALABAMA WMAs FOR THE ENTIRE YEAR.

ANNUAL SMALL GAME WMA LICENSE: PROVIDES ACCESS TO SPECIFIC WMAs FOR HUNTING SMALL GAME, OFTEN AT A REDUCED COST COMPARED TO THE FULL ANNUAL LICENSE.

DAILY WMA LICENSE: ALLOWS ACCESS TO WMAS FOR A SINGLE DAY. THIS IS IDEAL FOR OCCASIONAL VISITORS.

ADCNR OFFICES: YOU CAN OBTAIN YOUR LICENSE DIRECTLY FROM ADCNR OFFICES.

FEES AND ASSOCIATED COSTS:

THE COST OF AN ALABAMA WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA LICENSE VARIES DEPENDING ON THE TYPE OF LICENSE AND YOUR RESIDENCY STATUS (RESIDENT VS. NON-RESIDENT). IT'S CRUCIAL TO CHECK THE ADCNR WEBSITE FOR THE MOST UP-TO-DATE FEE SCHEDULE, AS PRICES CAN CHANGE.

REGULATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:
