This doping process involves a charge transfer between the dopant molecule and the polymer chain which are then supposed to be spatially close to each other. It follows that the mechanism of doping must be considered as an actual intercalation process, which will greatly affect the structural characteristics of the starting material, as well as its morphology, as has been observed during the intercalation of graphite and layered compounds. In parallel with these modifications, the band structure of the system changes yielding a new set of electronic properties.
