ACCESSIBILITY: THE ASSESSMENT SHOULD BE ACCESSIBLE TO ALL STUDENTS, REGARDLESS OF THEIR LEARNING STYLES OR DISABILITIES.

INTERPRETING AND USING ALGEBRA 1 PRE-ASSESSMENT RESULTS

DEVELOPING INTERVENTION STRATEGIES: BASED ON THE RESULTS, TEACHERS SHOULD DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT EFFECTIVE INTERVENTION STRATEGIES TO ADDRESS IDENTIFIED LEARNING GAPS.

MONITORING PROGRESS: TEACHERS SHOULD MONITOR STUDENT PROGRESS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR TO ASSESS THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THEIR INTERVENTIONS.
